Grover Sealant Gun Preventive Maintenance Model No. 223, 223AR, and 223AR-6

Grover Sealant Injection Guns should provide long, trouble free service with little preventive maintenance. The following simple basic procedures may insure longer service life of the parts.

- Sealant gun cleanliness is the most critical factor in preventive maintenance. Clean gun thoroughly after every use with the sealant manufacturer's recommended cleanser.
- 2. Each morning before operation, squeeze 2-3 squirts of 30 weight, nondetergent oil into the air intake of the air motor. An alternate solution would be to install an automatic oiler in the air line.
- 3. Maintain a clean air supply. Drain the air compressor regularly or install an air line filter into the main air line.
- 4. Disconnect the air supply to the gun when not in operation.

In case of a remote breakdown, we recommend purchasing a reserve gun to use while service is being performed.
